

1. Introduction

- 1) In order to access online services with e-Cert, your Microsoft windows is required to install **Hongkong Post e-Cert Thin Client** and the browser is required to install **Hongkong Post e-Cert Extension**.
- 2) When a subscriber accesses online services and selects **Hongkong Post e-Cert** as a login method, the system will check if the **Hongkong Post e-Cert Thin Client** has already been installed.



- 3) If the **Hongkong Post e-Cert Thin Client** has not been installed, you will be redirected to download the Thin Client Installer. Please follow the installation steps in Section 3 of this guide.

- 4) After successful installation, a dialog box will then pop up for selection of valid certificates as follows:-

In order to install the thin client, your system is required to have all as follows:-


1. **Microsoft Windows 10**


- 1) Click **Download** button to download the Thin Client Installer as follows:-




- 2) After running the installer, a dialog box is popped up to start installation. Click **Next** button to start as follows:-




- 3) Another dialog box is popped up to allow you to change the default folder to install. Click **Next** button as follows:-

- 5) After installation is completed, another dialog box is popped up. Click **Next** button as follows:-




4. Uninstallation Steps

To uninstall the **Hongkong Post e-Cert Thin Client**, follow steps below.


- 1) Click the “Start” button at the left of bottom task bar. A menu is then popped. On the left, click the **Settings icon** as follows:-




2) Control panel is then popped up, click **Apps** as follows:-
